Key Vocabulary

Limestone – A hard, pale rock made from the remains of sea creatures.

Quarry – A place where stone is dug out of the ground.

Border – A line that separates two countries or places.

Cliff – A steep rock face.

Fossil – The remains or shape of a plant or animal from long ago.

Hill – Land that is higher than the land around it.

Man made – something that is made by humans
