Most mosaics are made of small square shaped tiles, known as tesserae.

The **House of the Faun** was built in the second century BC. It is the largest and most decorative house in **Pompeii**. It is an excellent example of aristocratic life in the Roman era. This house gives us an insight into the lives and interests of the **aristocrats** in Rome at that time.

Within the house, archaelogists discovered elaborate decorations and mosaics that were preserved after the eruption of Mount Vesuvius, which occurred in AD79. Although many artefacts and artworks were discovered, the most significant findings were the remains of the human inhabitants that had been frozen in time.

The Anonymous Sea Creature mosaic informs us of the **marine** food that was available at that time. It was part of a central panel on the floor and was like a menu for visitors to the House of Faun. The mosaic has an octopus at its centre, wrapping its tentacles around a crayfish, and there are squid and eels around it. There is a small bird on a rock towards the left of the mosaic.
