Finding Out About the Past (Enquiry)	<p>Compare aspects of the present with the past and describe simple similarities and differences.</p> <p>Give reasons for and describe changes that have taken place within living memory.</p>
Finding Out About the Past (Chronology)	<p>Talk about events, places and people beyond living memory. (National or Global)</p> <p>Use historical terms to describe the passage of time, e.g. modern, recent, long ago, older etc.</p> <p>Place objects, people and events beyond own experiences in time order.</p>
Historical Events	<p>Talk about events and the lives of people beyond living memory. (Own locality)</p>
Lifestyles of People in the Past	<p>Talk about similarities and differences between their life and that of others.</p> <p>Describe similarities and differences between the lives of people.</p>
Significant Historical People	<p>Talk about important people beyond living memory using a range of historical vocabulary. (National and International achievements)</p>
